At this year's edition approximately 130 cyclers competed from more than 20 countries (Ukraine, Moldova, Montenegro, Slovakia, Bulgaria, Greece, Russia, Japan, Germany, Belgium, Norway, Turkey, Hungary, Romania, etc). Cycling Tour of Szeklerland is included from 2008 in the official UCI (Union Cycliste Internationale) calendar, being the most prestigious cycling event organized in Romania, next to the Tour of Romania.
